What is the TPV?

- The Applied Practical Activity (TPV) involves practical tasks under supervision to develop essential skills for psychologists. This includes tasks related to prevention, diagnosis, rehabilitation, psychological support, research, and teaching.

Duration of TPV

- Complete 500 hours of activities at accredited and affiliated institutions.

Where to Carry Out TPV

- TPV can be carried out at affiliated institution located both in Italy and abroad.

Characteristics of the host institution

- TPV **cannot** be carried out at any university institution.
- TPV institutions must have one or more psychologists who is willing to supervise the internship for its entire duration, as specified in the training project.
- If the TPV is conducted at a foreign institution, the supervisor must be a certified psychologist as defined by the local rules.

Starting the TPV

- Identify and contact a foreign institution.
- If the institution is not affiliated, email the Internship Office (sara.longo@unipv.it) to start the affiliation process.
- Provide required documents, such as the psychologist tutor's certificate, declaration of non-specialization, entity activity description, tutor's CV, and a personal internship project.
- Wait for approval from the Internship Commission.
- Follow the standard activation procedure once approved.
